#### **Background Information.**

Plan International is an independent development and humanitarian organization that advances children's rights and equality for girls. The Conservation and Sustainable Management of Coastal and Marine Ecosystems (COSME) project is a three-year initiative led by Plan International, which brings together several partners and stakeholders to significantly scale up Plan International Kenya's current women-led, climate-resilient livelihoods and coastal management project in Kwale(Msambweni and Lungalunga Sub Counties) and Kilifi (Kilifi North, South and Ganze sub Counties). Taking an ecosystems-based approach in partnership with the Jane Goodall Institute (JGI) Canada and Cascadia Seaweed, COSME will also capitalize on opportunities for South-South learning by working between Kenya and Tanzania cross-border communities within the same marine coastal and coastal forest eco-regions.

- 5. Indicate the warranty terms.
- 6. Proof of Environmental sustainability Practices.
