a) ACTIVITY DETAILS

Activity Name: Purchase of boats to support select seaweed groups to ease access to the ocean and transportation of seaweed.

b) ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION

One of the main challenges that seaweed groups face in seaweed farming is transportation. Lack of appropriate means to cross deep waters and access farms across continues to pull some groups like Mtimbwani, whose production has steadily risen over the years as a result of investments by the project and other stakeholders. Whereas they are employing the best management practices in their farming, there harvest is prone to losses due to transportation and drying challenges. This therefore seeks to address the challenge of transportation within the groups. Chiromo and Jimbo are the other groups that face transport problems and have high number of farmers in seaweed. Chiromo's will also support Amka Utsamba, Nuru Islamic and Daima as they are all within the same vicinity.

The activity aims to procure three boats to support Mtimbwani, Chiromo and Jimbo. The following are the boat details:
